Here you will discover two retention ponds with a boardwalk that attract 149 different species of birds including moorhens, gallinules, swallows, terns and gulls. Eagle Lakes Community Park is also listed on the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission's Birding Trail.

Meet in the parking lot.*

A 2.25-mile raised boardwalk takes visitors through four distinct environments: a pine upland, a wet prairie, a cypress forest, and a marsh. Birds, reptiles, mammals, insects, and a variety of native plants including wild orchids may be seen from the boardwalk.
