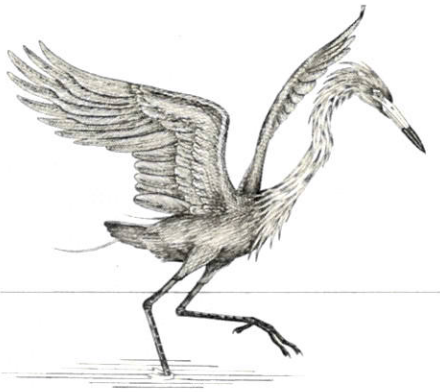


AUDUBON OF THE WESTERN EVERGLADES
